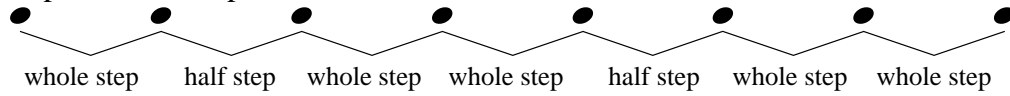
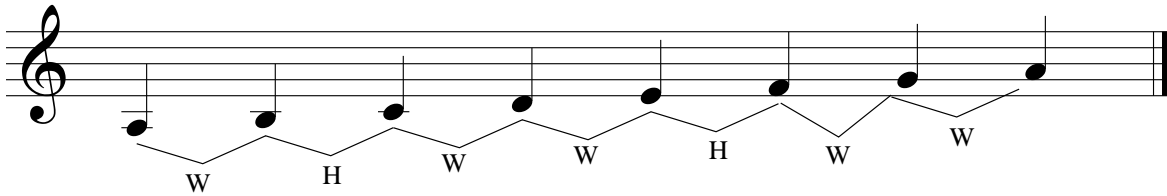


Lesson 20: The Natural Minor Scale
